Our staff are dedicated Christians, and this is demonstrated in the classroom as well as in all school-wide programs. All teachers are encouraged to take continuing education courses each year.

Solid Academic Program

You send your child to school to learn, and you want your child to have the best education possible. This is Miramonte School's highest priority. Our intimate 200-student campus means that our teachers get to know each child's abilities and learning style. Single-grade classrooms for Kindergarten through 5th grade, and subject-based middle-school departmentalization for select subject areas help to ensure optimal teacher/class instruction and learning. The curriculum includes all core subjects mandated by the State of California, but it goes beyond this in the areas of Bible and music curriculum. Parental involvement in school activities is welcome and encouraged.

More Than Book Learning

Your child's learning extends well beyond bookwork. Miramonte School's middle school students practice teambuilding skills through participation in intramural sport events. Whether it's on our recently renovated playground, on the track, or in the new gym shooting hoops, your child learns how to care for God's wonderful gift of a healthy body. Developing musical skills is possible through participation in various musical opportunities such as band, the recorder and hand bell choirs, and private on-campus music lessons. Drama and musical programs are practiced and presented throughout the school year in on-campus and church venues. Throughout the school year, various off-campus field trips open up new worlds of wonder and excitement—inspiring young minds to stretch for new goals.

Functional Facilities

Computers are available in each classroom as well as in a computer lab. The library is a popular destination for all students, and the new music facilities foster musical appreciation for all who choose to participate. When the bell rings for recess, your child can head out to our recently renovated playground, run laps on the track, or join a game of baseball or soccer on well-maintained turf.

Safe Place for Learning
