

How to Enroll your Child at Miramonte School

Please complete the following check list.

Step 1

- Complete the Miramonte Application form (Green Colored Card)
- Pay the Application Fee (A non-refundable processing fee of \$125.00 per student, paid in advance, will hold a place for your child.

Step 2

- Documented immunization history
- A recent report card or standardized testing from previous school attended

Step 3

Miramonte School will provide you with the following registration forms: (Please complete and return by June 15, 2010)

- Registration Summary (Peach Card, one per family)
- Pacific Union Conference Student Application (White sheet, one per student)
- Consent to Treat (White Sheet, one per student)
- Parent Agreement (Yellow Sheet, one per family, signed by parent and student)
- Student Medical Record & Physical Exam, (Goldenrod Sheet, one per student))
- Volunteer Agreement (Blue Sheet, one per family)
- School Assisted Medication (Violet Sheet, one per student, must be signed by the parent and the prescribing physician)
- Sports Program Parent Permission and Medical Clearance (Pink sheet, one per student, must be signed by both parent and physician, applies to grades 5-8 only)
- T-shirt order, Green sheet one per family, Grades 1-4 only)
- Request for Student Records (White sheet, one per student)
- Reference Forms (White forms, three per student)
- Pay Registration Fee (Due June 15, with the above forms)

Step 4

- Financial Agreement (White Sheet, one per family, requires signature of the person who is responsible for the student's account).

Note:

Seventh Grade Students: The Student Medical Record (Goldenrod Sheet) is to be turned in after your child's physician has completed and signed the form. Make your appointment NOW for this exam because it becomes more difficult to see your doctor with so many students needing physical exams before school admission. Please return this form as soon as it is completed.

Fingerprint Policy - Adults

Parents/Guardians will only be able to attend field trips (in any capacity) if their fingerprint clearance has been received by the school. If you plan to drive you will need to have a valid driver's license and current insurance information on file in the school office prior to the field trip.
