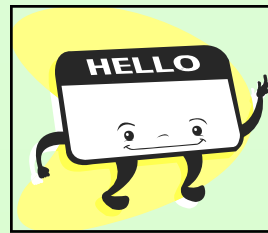
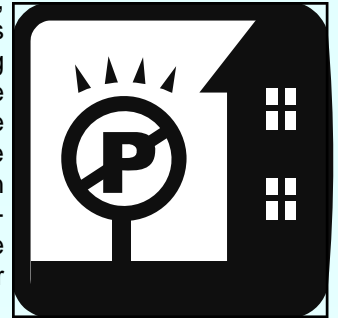

## Parking on the Street

For a period of time now, the neighbors of Blach school (diagonal and across the street from us) have been concerned about the drop off traffic along Carmel Terrace and Altamead Drive as parents drop their students off at the back gate of Blach School. The parents have been urged to use the front entrance, but this has not worked. The city of Los Altos has stepped in and designated this area around Blach School as a no stopping zone/no parking zone from 7 AM until 10 AM on school days. Signs have been posted, and enforcement will start shortly. While most of you drop off your students in our parking lot, some of you do not enter the Miramonte School lot. Depending on where you stop, you could be cited for violating the No Stopping Zone. There is to be no stopping or parking within 100 feet of the marking signs. This covers about up to the entrance to Miramonte School. The only way you would be allowed to park on the street within this area is to have a parking permit issued by the city. These are only given to residents of the area. I have been told that enforcement will begin this week. The first week, violators will be issued warnings. After that, violators will be cited. For the safety of your children, the best way to drop your children off at Miramonte will be for you to enter our parking lot.

When you visit the school or volunteer in a classroom, please remember to check in at the office. All visitors and volunteers need to have a badge while here at school during regular school hours. We need to know who is here for emergency evacuation reasons as well as to maintain a positive educational environment for the students.

## Accessing RenWeb

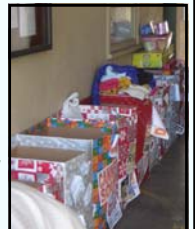
If you have provided the school with a valid email address, you are able to access your child's school records through RenWeb. The basic instructions are:

- Go to [www.renweb.com](http://www.renweb.com).
- Select the Login tab from the upper part of the window.
- Follow the instructions. Our initial school ID is CCC-SDA.
- During the registration, you will be asked for your email address. This must match the one that you provided to the school.
- RenWeb will then email you a password and instructions on how to log in.
