Accessing RenWeb

If you have provided the school with a valid email address, you are able to access your child's school records through RenWeb. The basic instructions are:

- Go to www.renweb.com.
- Select the Login tab from the upper part of the window.
- Follow the instructions. Our initial school ID is CCC-SDA.
- During the registration, you will be asked for your email address. This must match the one that you provided to the school.
- RenWeb will then email you a password and instructions on how to log in.

If you have changed your email, please let us know so that we can place your new email into the system.

The BASIC Fund

The BASIC fund is a privately funded program dedicated to broadening the educational opportunities for children of reduced income families. Depending on income level, this scholarship can be up to \$1600 per year. However, this fund only applies to students attending a private school for the first time.
