Junior Kindergarten Enrollment Eligibility:

All children who are 4 years old on or before December 2 of the current school year are eligible for enrollment into the Junior Kindergarten program.

Please complete the following check list.

Step 1

- Complete the Miramonte Application form (Raspberry Card)
- Pay the Application Fee (A non-refundable processing fee of \$125.00 per student, paid in advance, will hold a place for your child.)

Step 2

Please provide the following documents:

- Birth Certificate or Passport
- Documented Immunization History

Step 3

Miramonte School will provide you with the following registration forms: (Please complete and return by June 15, 2010)

- Registration Summary (Peach Card, one per family)
- Admissions Agreement (White sheet, one per student)
- Pacific Union Conference Student Application (White Sheet, one per student)
- Consent to Treat (White Sheet, one per student)
- Parent Agreement (Yellow Sheet one per family, signed by parent and student)
- Child's Preadmission Health History (Yellow sheet, one per student)
- Physician's Report, Blue Sheet one per student completed signed by physician)
- Identification & Emergency Information (Goldenrod sheet, one per student)
- Child Care Center Notification of Parent's Rights (White sheet, one per student)
- Personal Rights (White sheet, one per student)
- School Assisted Medication (Violet Sheet, one per student, must be signed by the parent and the prescribing physician)
- Volunteer Agreement (Blue Sheet, one per family)
- T-shirt Order (Green Sheet, one per family)
- Pay Registration Fee (Due June 15, with above forms)

Step 4

- Financial Agreement (White Sheet, one per family, requires signature of the person who is responsible for the student account).

Note:

The Physician's Report (Blue Sheet) is to be turned in after your child's physician has completed and signed the form. Make your appointment NOW for this exam, because it becomes more difficult to see your doctor with so many students needing physical exams before school admission. Please return this form as soon as it is completed.

Fingerprint Policy - Adults

Parents/Guardians will only be able to attend field trips (in any capacity) if their fingerprint clearance has been received by the school. If you plan to drive, you will need to have a valid driver's license and current insurance information on file in the school office prior to the field trip.
